If you reach SCOTT MILL RD you've gone a little too far **Go 11.0 Mi** 11.6 mi



4. HICKORY FLAT HWY becomes ARNOLD MILL RD / GA-140. **Go 3.3 Mi** 14.9 mi



5. Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto CRABAPPLE RD.
CRABAPPLE RD is 0.1 miles past EDENWILDE DR **Go 2.4 Mi** 17.3 mi



6. Turn SLIGHT LEFT onto E CROSSVILLE RD / GA-92 E.
E CROSSVILLE RD is 0.1 miles past MACY DR **Go 1.3 Mi** 18.6 mi



7. E CROSSVILLE RD / GA-92 E becomes HOLCOMB BRIDGE RD / GA-140 E. **Go 1.2 Mi** 19.8 mi



8. Turn RIGHT onto DOGWOOD RD.
DOGWOOD RD is 0.2 miles past RIVERWOOD LN **Go 1.0 Mi** 20.8 mi



9. DOGWOOD RD becomes RIVERSIDE RD. **Go 0.6 Mi** 21.4 mi

FEBRUARY 5, 2011

President Katie Glowka thanked women of St. Vincent de Paul Catholic Church for hosting the meeting.

Opening prayer was said by Mary Lang.

Katie introduced the officers: Julie Pardo, Vice- President was not in attendance, Marie Kwiatkowski – Secretary, Audrey Lee – Treasurer.

Secretary, Marie Kwiatkowski read the minutes from the November 2, 2010 meeting. There were no corrections/additions.

Treasurer, Audrey Lee –We have a balance of \$1,105.09.

President, Katie Glowka introduced the Speaker –Joyce Fowler, Co-President of the St. Vincent de Paul Society. She was raised a Baptist and came into the Catholic Church 6 years ago. The parish family is very caring and are there to help with whatever project comes up. The Ladies Guild prepares food for funeral receptions. They also hold in November a Christmas Festival – This year they will not hold one.

This past year, St. Vincent de Paul Society paid \$2560 bills in Paulding County. They have fed 1521 people. A thrift store has opened through the help of the members of the parish. They are in partnership with the Atlanta Food Bank.

President Katie Glowka announce 14 parishes were represented at Recognition Day. Capital Day will be held February 17, 2011.

Katie introduced Shirley Towle, AACCW President and Joan Brown, Immediate Past President. Shirley added the fund raiser for Mustard Seed brought in \$5,772.86.

Mary Lou Bishop gave a brief history of St. Vincent de Paul Parish. In 1981 a priest was requested to say Mass on Saturdays at a local Funeral home. November 1981 St. Vincent de Paul became a Mission Church of St. John Vianney in Lithia Springs. In 1995 dedication took place and 2003 St. Vincent de Paul became a Parish. In September, 2010 a new building was dedicated.


