- **Immaculate Conception, Atlanta, Georgia**

√ ***Baptisms 1846-1871 Confirmations 1862-1871.*** * Inside title: *Register of the Catholic Church of Atlanta and the counties which may be attached to that mission.* No Index. Letter inserted dated May 24, 1967 regarding microfilming of this volume and the next one by the Department of Archives & History. Stamp on flyleaf indicating it was microfilmed February 20, 1967. Red buckram hard bound. Rebound notice tipped-in dated “8/17” [1954]. This is the companion volume to *Marriages 1846-1871*. See Access database Index – printed version is with the book.

√ ***Marriages 1846-1871.*** * Missing pages. Loose pages. No Index. Stamp on flyleaf indicating it was microfilmed by the state February 20, 1967. Red buckram hard bound. Rebound notice tipped-in dated “8/17/1954.” This is the companion volume to *Baptisms 1846-1871*. Typed Index was later prepared and is with the book.

Baptisms 1872-1888. Printed title page: *Baptismorum Registrum...* Baltimore, 1870. Twelve page Index in front. First sheet (pages 1 and 2) missing of baptismal records. Red buckram hard bound. Rebound notice tipped-in dated “8/17 [1954].” This is probably the companion volume to *Marriages 1873-1923* – similar in style. No indication that it has been microfilmed.

Marriages 1873-1923. Printed title page missing. Heading on pages – *Registrum Matrimoniorum in Ecclesia*. Eight page Index in front. First sheet (pages 1 and 2) of marriage records missing. Red buckram hard bound. Note on inside cover “Rebound in 1954.” Rebound notice loose dated “.../17/54.” This is probably the companion volume to *Baptisms 1872-1888* – similar in style. No indication that it has been microfilmed.

Baptismorum Registrum 1888-1902 (actual dates 1888-1900). No printed title page. Heading on pages – *Registrum Baptizatorum in Ecclesia*. Green buckram hard bound and red leather. Looks like it has been rebound. No rebound notice. No indication that it has been microfilmed.

Baptisms Record 1901-1920. Printed title page *Baptismorum Registrum* ...Baltimore, 1871. Thirty page Index in front. Red buckram hard bound. Rebound notice tipped-in on title page dated “8/7” [1954]. No indication that it has been microfilmed.

Record of Internments 1881-1910. Printed title page: *Record of Interments* ...Baltimore, 1871. Twelve pages of Index in front. Red buckram hard bound. Rebound notice tipped-in dated “...17/54.” No indication it has been microfilmed.

Registrum Confirmatorum 1871-1921. Printed title page: *Confirmatorum Registrum* ...Baltimore, 1971. Blank index pages in front. Red buckram. Rebound notice tipped-in dated “...17” [8/17/1954]. No indication it has been microfilmed.

- **Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Sharon, Georgia**

√ *Baptisms Marriages Confirmation Trustees 1822 to 1844 Warren & Wilkes counties.** (typed labels scotch taped to front cover). New brown spine with title in gold, *Catholic Church Records Church of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary 1822-1844*. Stamp on inside cover indicates “Laminated and Microfilmed by GA. Dept. of Archives and History Oct. 11, 1957” [The one volume contains a brief history (1790-1830) by John England, Bishop of Charleston; Baptisms including Slaves, 1822-1844; Marriages, 1824-1855 (bound in the back upside down); Confirmations (a few misc. dates); Burials & Internments (1827-1845); and miscellaneous notations regarding trustees.]

Register of Baptisms at Locust Grove & Sharon, Ga. From 1845 (gold lettering on label pasted on front cover). Bulk dates 1845-1946 (also Confirmations, Marriages, and Funerals). Title on the first page, *Register of Baptisms at the Church of the Purification of the B.V. Mary (...Sharon) and of St. Patrick (Washington)*. Pages numbered 1-288 (missing 264-275). Index printed in red and created in 1946, begins on page 176. Loose pages in front. Book needs preservation treatment. No indication it has been microfilmed.

- **Saint Joseph (also known as Saint Patrick), Washington, Georgia**

√ *St. Joseph's St. Patrick's Register Washington, GA. 1854-1924** (gold lettering on new spine; no title on cover). Handwritten title on first page inside, *Baptismal Register of St. Joseph's Church Washington, Georgia*. Stamp on inside cover indicates “Laminated and Microfilmed by GA. Dept. of Archives and History June 16, 1958.” [The one volume contains Baptisms, many written in Latin, Confirmations, First Communion Classes, and Marriages. The last page includes a recipe on “How to Save Books (especially old European books).”]

Regesta Paroeciae (stamped in gold on front of blue cloth cover); *Registra Baptismorum, Matrimoniorum et Defunctorum...*, 1929-1954. Printed register book by Apud B. Herder Book Co., Sancti Ludovici, 1927. Handwritten note on title page, “By order of the Bishop, His Excellency F. E. Hyland, the registration on this Book is stopped at June 1954. From June 1954 on see Combined Register.” Index in front. Weak binding. Acidic pages. No indication it has been microfilmed.

√ Found indications that register may have been microfilmed in the 1950s by the Georgia State Archives. The Archdiocese does not possess any microfilm copies of church records.
