

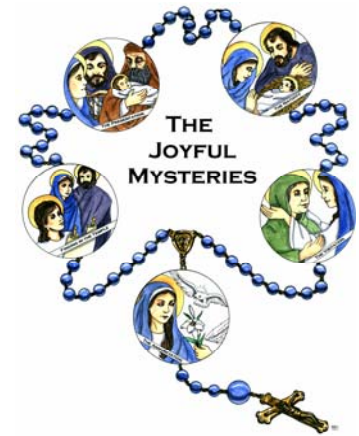
## The Rosary: Activities for Children and Families

### Creative Suggestions

“The uses for this artwork are as limitless as your own imagination in color or black and white depending on your application! From bulletin boards to worksheets or Rosary booklets, the images here can be combined in many, many ways to help teach, promote, and pray the Holy Rosary. When we designed these pieces, we did come up with some unique ideas on how to use them. Try printing out ten mystery ‘beads’ and ten Hail Mary ‘beads’ for each mystery, etc. printing all the beads and their prayers. Print the center and crucifix both front and back with prayers. Don’t forget the Glory Be and Fatima prayer ‘tags.’ You can size all of these things to fit your needs, from a large bulletin board, classroom or family size, or a smaller personal size. Just make sure they are in proportion with each other (all the beads the same size) and readable. Cut out the pieces and construct a Rosary using yarn or cord. Glue the beads back to back with the mystery on one side and prayer on the other. Punch holes in the tags, center, and crucifix to thread the yarn through or tie on. This is a fun project and also a great visual aid for helping others understand the concept of saying a prayer while meditating on a mystery at the same time.
